\$	Matter	Description
1.	PDMI	The president declares the meeting to be initiated.
2.	Election of chairperson and secretary	Two candidates for chairperson and secretary of the parliament have been located.
		SUGGESTION to elect a chairperson and secretary for the academic year of 2017/18.
3.	Adjustment of electoral register	The secretary will call out the names of the parliament members. According to the statutes of LUNA, at least eight (8) of its members have to be present for the parliament to be allowed to make formal decisions.
		SUGGESTION to adjust the electoral register according to above.
4.	Rules of notification of the meeting	According to the statutes of LUNA, a notification should be sent out no later than 15 weekdays before the meeting.
		The meeting was summoned a little late as not all student councils had yet elected nor reported their representatives to the presidium.
		SUGGESTION to approve that the notification of the meeting was done in enough of a timely manner to proceed.
5.	Approval of the agenda	If any matters are to be added or removed from the agenda, or changed in any way, it is to be done now.
		SUGGESTION to approve of the agenda.

6. Election of adjusters

14. Discussion: Brunnshög Rapporteur: Ida Lunga

With the construction and completion of MAX IV and ESS, a joint research site named Science Village Scandinavia (SVS) is to be installed by the region, municipality, and the university. Part of both the Faculty of Engineering, the Faculty of Medicine, and the Faculty of Science are interested in taking part of this project.

Moving departments or parts of departments could have great impact on education and the student situation. The board wishes the parliament to hold an orienting discussion on the topic for the executive part of the union to better represent the student population.

Things to consider for discussion:

- possible closer connection between education research
- split campus and divisions within the faculty
- greater geographical distances
- access to MAX IV and ESS
- difficulties with interdisciplinary science
- new locals
- scheduling and administration of education

The work of the student unions of Lund University is to take part in decision processes too represent the student opinion and defend student rights. In this process it has yet not been the case but is turning around. The process has appeared much more fast-paced than it actually is as LU Bygg has not yet been involved in the matter. This means proper analysing of the situation will take place and that the student can be involved in the process. LUS (Lunds Universitets Studentkårer) has decided to stand united in the matter.
